The purpose of water quality reports is to inform customers about the source of their drinking water, the quality of their water supply, testing results performed during 2021 and ongoing efforts to maintain the highest standards.

Our "Water for Tomorrow®" infrastructure campaign is a multi-year, multimillion-dollar initiative to further enhance our water delivery network in New Jersey, maintain and improve system pressures and available storage, reduce lost water and continue to maintain the safety of our treatment process. This includes our annual RENEW Program where we replace valves, hydrants, water mains and service lines. The RENEW 2022 Program has expanded to now include the identification and removal of lead and galvanized steel service lines on both the customer-owned and company-owned portions of the service lines. This measured approach, within a defined RENEW project scope area, enables the Company to strategically and efficiently perform as many upgrades as possible while minimizing repeated impact to customers.

Middlesex Water encourages everyone to join in protecting drinking water sources for current and future generations by considering the following:

- Check with your local municipality to learn how to dispose of household hazardous wastes such as motor oil, paint and pharmaceuticals properly.
- o Keep chemicals and debris out of storm drains, which may flow into surface waterways.
- Limit the use of fertilizer, pesticides and herbicides on your property.
- o Practice wise water use (repair leaking faucets or toilets, etc.)
- o Consider installing WaterSense® labeled water-efficient products.
