




## **REVENUE SOURCES – TTM Q3 2019**





## **O & M EXPENSE – TTM Q3 2019**






## **NET INCOME**

## **DILUTED EARNINGS PER SHARE**






## **DIVIDENDS PAID**






## **DIVIDEND PAYOUT RATIO**



## **UTILITY PLANT**


